A.L.T. (Adult Leadership Team) Covenant

Because we know that our lives will teach the next generation far more than our words will.....

1) We will endeavor to live before God, and particularly before our families and the young people we work with, in a way that seeks to honor Christ with our words, attitudes, and actions.

2) We will seek to grow in our own love for God by practicing the very same **H.A.B.I.T.S.** of godliness we want to instill in our students:

Hang time with God—setting aside regular time to be in intentional conversation

with God (whether 5 minutes a week or 30 minutes a day, the focus is on practicing the proactive discipline of making the time for prayer).

Accountability Partners—developing at least one purposeful friendship in which

conversations about matters of faith and priorities take place.

Bible Memory—following the Biblical principle to “write scripture on your heart” and to commit to reading scripture throughout the year, whether one verse a year or a verse a week.

Involvement in the Church—worshipping with the church family and finding a

place to be involved in the church outside the youth ministry.

Tithing—giving intentionally to the work of God and being an example of a cheerful giver.

Servant's Heart—Finding ways to serve those who may never be able to return that service.

3) We will seek to live in such a way that our lives are examples of integrity, faithfulness, and love for God, including...

a. intentionally building healthy relationships, being particularly attentive to our

spouses' and children's needs.

b. honorable in our marriages and pure in our singleness.

c. speaking edifying words and avoiding complaint, gossip, and profanity.

d. make it a personal policy not to consume alcohol and avoid taking students to public places, including sports bars, where alcohol might be consumed in excess by other patrons.

e. mindful of appropriateness of dress and conduct

4) We will seek to make our homes and our vehicles safe places for students by...

- a. being supportive of other parents' values concerning the appropriateness of movies and music for their children.
- b. being particularly attentive to driving the speed limit when transporting children and requiring that our passengers wear seatbelts, and NEVER texting or operating electronic equipment (i-pods, etc.) while driving.
- c. protecting our home from inappropriate material on the internet.

5) We will serve as a part of the student ministries team by...

- a. attending A.L.T. meetings.
- b. regularly be in touch with our assigned students and/or their parents.
- c. alert/advise Ace regarding students who require special care or attention.
- d. participating in student ministry activities (Bible studies, small groups, student services, & special events) as time allows.
